



Full-time Research Scientist Positions in Health Technologies

<u>Porto Research, Technology & Innovation Center (PORTIC)</u> is a new infrastructure of the Polytechnic Institute of Porto that integrates and connects research centers, industrial laboratories and companies, in the same physical space, to foster research and innovation.

Following a **strategic plan of research development**, supported by regional funds, PORTIC is looking for **2 full-time research scientists**, in the area of **Health Technologies**. The selected researchers will **contribute and drive research** within a broad strategic plan including, but not restricted to, topics of:

Area: Health technologies

- a. Digital health and telehealth
- b. IoT for smart healthcare
- c. Sensor technology
- d. Smart and personal devices

Candidates should have a PhD degree in Computer Science, Electrical and Computer Engineering, Software Engineering or Applied Mathematics, or similar, a **publication record** and preferably with **experience in research projects**.

The selected researchers are expected to **proactively** collaborate in the **definition and implementation of the research area strategy**, promote and **drive research activities** leading to a **strong publication effort**, and **lead research funding proposals**.

PORTIC offers an **excellent working environment**, with **multidisciplinary teams** and **career development possibilities**. The researchers will work in a **highly collaborative environment** with other members of the center and industry collaborators, in an **open and fertile environment**.

Selected candidates will be employed with a **contract of 3 to 6 years**, starting tentatively in November 2020, with a **gross monthly salary of roughly 3200** €, following the **14 times per year** salary model in Portugal.

The formal call for applications, following the Portuguese law applicable (DL 57/2016), will be issued by the end of September.

The <u>Polytechnic Institute of Porto (P.PORTO)</u> is one of the largest higher education institutions in Portugal, with more than 18,000 students in different areas of knowledge such as Engineering, Health, Accounting and Administration; Education; Music and Performing Arts; Media Arts and Design; Hospitality and Tourism; and Management and Technology.

P.PORTO is a relatively young institution, but resulting from the aggregation of schools, some with more than 100 years of history and long-standing activities. This new ecosystem strengthens the idea of an environment that stimulates synergies, the fertile crossing between areas of knowledge, adding skills and teams, fostering cooperation and formation of joint projects, in a space of knowledge, science, transfer and reproduction in line with international best practices.

The PORTIC complex integrates 3 interconnected buildings, including structures such as offices, laboratories, meeting rooms and auditoriums, as well as leisure areas, comprising an area of more than 16 thousand square meters located in the heart of the Asprela Campus, the Porto Innovation District.

About Porto

<u>Porto</u> is located in the North of Portugal and it is one of the main economic and industrial centres in the country.
